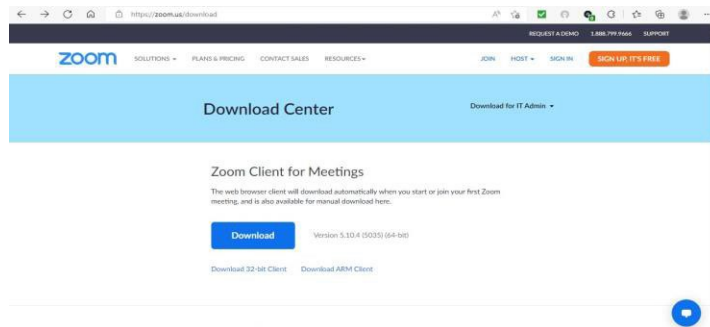

ACTIVITIES

1. **Reflection time** – discuss any issues and reflect on the process. What did you learn about the programme? What did you learn about your whānau?
2. Whānau member interview: - discussion time – As a group come up with at least 10 interview questions. Add to slide.
3. **Video techniques** – special guest Sebastian Lowe (ethnographic filmmaker). See https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=G_YxnWbFbM for an example of our short film he helped Lily make with Ngātiwai and Te Kapotai rangatahi. Featuring our marae, our whanau, Willow-Jean Prime and Peeni Henare!
4. **Continue researching tupuna/ancestor histories** – Compile enough information for you to write a small biography on your chosen tupuna.
5. **Ahau** – Continue adding information you have gathered from home, including photographs.
